**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EXISTING 911 EMERGENCY
TELEPHONE SERVICE FEE AND ESTABLISHING FEES TO BE COLLECTED
FROM OLDHAM COUNTY TELEPHONE SUBSCRIBERS WHO ARE SERVED
BY OLDHAM COUNTY'S 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE**

Whereas, Oldham County has established 911 emergency telephone service available to all telephone subscribers located in Oldham County, Kentucky, and,

Whereas, the 911 emergency telephone service is needed, well accepted, and growing with growth of Oldham County; and,

Whereas, the 1986 Kentucky legislature recognized the need for 911 emergency telephone service to the residents of the Commonwealth of authorizing local governments to charge fees to local subscribers to pay the cost of establishing and maintaining said emergency services pursuant to KRS 65.760 and 65.7621; and,

Whereas, the said Fiscal Court did adopt an ordinance establishing a 911 funding fee at its meeting of July 22, 1986, amended said ordinance on October 7, 1986 and December 19, 1995 and September 1, 1999; and,

Whereas, the Oldham County Fiscal Court, has after study and review, determined it in the best interest of the residents of the County of Oldham to increase the tax rate to produce sufficient revenue to pay for said service; and,

Whereas, the Oldham County Fiscal Court did conduct an advertised public hearing on the issue of amending it's 911 emergency telephone service funding ordinance of July 22, 1986 in order to provide for enhanced services and to increase fees for residential and commercial telephone subscribers in order to fund said enhanced services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE
COUNTY OF OLDHAM, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY THAT:**

An additional 911 emergency telephone service funding fee of fifty Cents (.50) per month be collected from each residential telephone subscriber located in Oldham County, Kentucky and served by the 911 emergency telephone service making a total fee of (\$2.00) per month, and an additional 911 emergency service funding fee of fifty cents (.50) per month to be collected from each commercial telephone subscriber located in Oldham County, Kentucky and served by the 911 emergency telephone service making a total fee of (\$3.40) per month.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
