AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EXISTING COMPREHENSIVE COUNTY DOG LICENSING AND ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE NO. 04-840-184.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, Oldham Fiscal Court has the authority pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapters 67, 100, and other applicable law to amend ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Oldham Fiscal Court did advertise and conduct a hearing on the requested amendment to the Comprehensive County Dog Licensing and Animal Control Ordinance, and said Fiscal Court having voted to grant requested amendment at its regular meeting conducted April 6, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF OLDHAM, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, THAT:

1) The following language is hereby **deleted** from **SECTION VIII - NUISANCE**, located on page 9:

No owner shall fail to exercise proper care and control of his animals so as to prevent the following actions: excessive, continuous or untimely barking or howling exceeding fifteen (15) minutes; molesting of passersby; chasing of vehicles; attacking of domestic animals; trespassing upon public and school grounds; trespassing upon private property; or damaging of property of any nature.

2) The following language is hereby **added** to **SECTION VIII - NUISANCE**, located on page 9:

No owner shall fail to exercise proper care and control of his animals so as to prevent the following actions: excessive, continuous or untimely barking or howling;


molesting of passersby; chasing of vehicles; attacking of domestic animals; trespassing upon public and school grounds; trespassing upon private property; or damaging of property of any nature.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and advertisement according to law.
