Beginning Youth Golf Clinic

Oldham County Parks and Recreation along with Crestwood Driving Range offers a six-week golf program each summer for children ages 6-12. The clinic meets one evening per week at the Crestwood Driving Range beginning in early June. The cost is \$75 and includes a golf hat for each participant. Registration begins April 1st.

Beginning Youth Tennis Lessons

Each summer we offer beginning tennis lessons for kids ages 6-8 and 9-12. Lessons meet at the courts at Wendell Moore Park, Briar Hill Park and Immaculate Conception. Morning classes: Meet twice a week for four weeks for \$48.00; Evening classes: Meet once a week for 6 weeks for \$36. There is a maximum of 8 students per class, minimum of 4. Sessions start in early June each year. Registration begins April 1st.
