Adult Tennis Lessons

Oldham County Parks and Recreation is now offer tennis lessons for adults. Lessons meet on the courts at Wendell Moore Park, Briar Hill Park and Immaculate Conception. Co-ed Softball Tournament

Oldham County Parks and Recreation is now accepting registrations for a Co-ed Softball Tournament. The format will be a double elimination tournament held on April 12th & 13th. The cost is \$190.00 per team. **Registration will end on April 8th at 12:00 p.m.** All games will be played at Wendell Moore Park. Tournament champs receive \$200.00 off entry into the spring league, sponsor's trophy and T-shirts.

Men's Softball Tournament

Oldham County Parks and Recreation is now accepting registrations for a Men's U.S.S.S.A Softball Tournament. The format will be a double elimination tournament held on August 2nd & 3rd. The cost is \$190.00 per team. **Registration will end on July 29th at 12:00 p.m.** All games will be played at Wendell Moore Park. Tournament champs receive a paid entry into the fall softball league, sponsor's trophy and T-shirts.

Championship Golf Tournament: July 26th & 27th: OC Country Club

The county golf champion is crowned yearly in July. The registration fee of \$80.00 includes green fees for both days and awards for each flight. Registration begins May 1st and runs until 3 days before the event. Tee times start at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday and 1:00 p.m. on Sunday. Tournament is open to males ages 16 and over.

Leagues

U.S.S.S.A. Spring and Fall Softball Leagues

Registration for men's, coed and women's spring softball begins March 1st. The registration fee is \$335.00 per team (includes U.S.S.S.A. sanction fee) for a 9 game schedule plus a single-elimination tournament. Summer league play begins the week of April 7th. Fall league registration begins July 1st with play starting the second week in August. Fall leagues provide 6 games plus a single-elimination tournament for \$260. A variety of nights and levels are offered. League champs receive T-shirts and a sponsor's trophy. Tournament champs receive T-shirts.

Adult Volleyball Leagues

Adult men & coed volleyball leagues begin play in January each year at OC Middle School. Registration is accepted October 1st through mid January. The league fee of \$140.00 per team includes a 7-game schedule plus a single-elimination tournament.

Tennis Leagues

Registration for men and women singles spring tennis leagues begins March 1st. Men's league will be held on Thursday nights and women on Monday nights. The registration fee is \$40.00 per player for an 8 match schedule. League play will begin the week of May 12th. All players will receive a T-shirt and league winners will receive a plaque.

Teen Kickball League

The fun doesn't have to stop just because you grew up! Come get your kicks in our coed teen league for ages 13 and up! Games will be played on Saturday mornings starting in May at our softball complex. The league fee of \$75.00 per team or \$7.50 per person gets you 6 games plus a season-ending tournament.

Oldham County Parks and Recreation is now offering a Duathlon on June 21st. This event combines running and biking into one race. Participant will run a 3K, that includes firm surfaces and cross-country segments, a 10 miles bike ride, on a non-closed road course, and finish up with another 3K run. The race costs \$25.00 per individual. Non-USAT members must add \$10.00 per participant to cover one-day insurance. The top two finishers in a variety of age groups as well as the men & women's overall winner receive awards. Registration begins April 1st and must be turned in by June 17th.

Mini-Triathlon: Saturday, September 6th

Our USAT sanctioned Mini-Triathlon is held at Wendell Moore Park on the first Saturday after Labor Day. The event includes a 400-meter pool swim, an 8-mile bike ride on a non-closed road course and a 3K run that includes firm surfaces and cross-country segments. The race costs \$25.00 per individual and \$55.00 for three-person teams. Non-USAT members must add \$10.00 per participant to cover one-day insurance. The top two finishers in a variety of age groups as well as the team, men & women's overall winners receive awards. Registration begins July 1st and must be turned in by August 26th by 12:00 p.m. Maximum participation is 200 entries.
