Requirements for bidding (these requirements become part of the contract for successful bidder):

- To be considered for this request, the office of the Maintenance Director must receive a complete bid package using this Form by 12:00 p.m. (noon) on May 26, 2010. The bid must be a lump sum for the total contract price.
- By making a bid, the applicant stipulates that they have visited the site(s) and have an understanding of the scope of work.
- Bids should be submitted in a sealed envelope with the company name, street address, bid due date and project name: "HVAC Replacement Project"
- The start date of the project must be approved by the Maintenance Director. All work must be started within 30 days of the award and completed within 45 days of the start date.
- Any questions or differences of opinion relative to the equipment or aspects of the work shall be brought to the attention of the Maintenance Director prior to the deadline for bid submission.
- All bidders must carry a warranty for work performed in this bid package for two calendar years and a warranty on compressors for five (5) calendar years from the date of acceptance by the Maintenance Director.
- All bidders and their employees, assigns, subcontractors, etc. must be fully covered by Workmen's Compensation and other insurance requirements as detailed in the Contract Specifications section of this document.
- Bid proposal shall remain unaltered unless bidders are directed otherwise by amendment.

- Bidder is responsible for receiving and responding to all amendments.
- Make sure you have bid on all items and every page should identify the bidder.
- Before you submit your bid, you should double check your computations, both numeric and written words.
- Make sure you sign the bid.

Oldham County Fiscal Court reserves the right to waive any irregularities and/or reject any or all bids. Oldham County Fiscal Court also reserves the right to negotiate changes in the scope of work before or after the bid has been awarded.
