The Oldham County Fiscal Court will receive sealed Bids for the Commerce Parkway Trail, Phase 2 Extension until 12 P.M., local time, May 18, 2010, at 100 W. Jefferson Street, Suite 4, La Grange Kentucky 40031. The Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2 P.M. in the Fiscal Court Room.

The Work includes the construction of approximately 0.35 mile of 10-foot wide asphalt pedestrian trail and related work consisting of grading, drainage, signing, and striping.

Bids are to be addressed to the Oldham County Fiscal Court, 100 West Jefferson Street, Suite 4, La Grange, Kentucky 40031 and shall be marked "Sealed Bid–Oldham County Commerce Parkway Trail, Phase 2 Extension–Contract 1-2010."

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office which is Strand Associates, Inc.®, 325 West Main Street, Suite 710, Louisville, Kentucky 40202. A nonrefundable fee of \$90 will be required (shipping and handling fees included). Overnight mailing of Bidding Documents will not be provided.

Bidders who submit a Bid must be a Plan Holder of record at the Issuing Office. Bids from Bidders who are not on the Plan Holders List may be returned as not being responsive.

Plan Holders are requested to provide an e-mail address if they wish to receive addenda and other information electronically. Plan Holders are requested to designate whether they are a prime contractor, subcontractor, or supplier if they want this information posted on the project Plan Holders List.

No Bid will be received unless accompanied by a cashier's, certified or bank check or a Bid Bond equal to at least 5 percent of the maximum Bid, payable to the OWNER as a guarantee that after a Bid is accepted, Bidder will execute and file the Agreement and 100% Performance and Payment Bonds within 15 days after the Notice of Award.

Bidders shall comply with federal wage rate requirements for the Project.

The Oldham County Fiscal County reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any technicality, and to accept any Bid which it deems advantageous. All Bids shall remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the time set for receiving Bids.

Contract award shall be made based on the lowest responsive, responsible Bid.

Construction contractors and subcontractors must be prequalified by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC). A list of prequalified contractors and information on the prequalification of contractors is located at the KYTC Division of Construction Procurement Web site as follows:

The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal established for this project is 5 percent. Bids submitted that do not include certification of DBE participation will not be read publicly.

All taxes are the responsibility of the successful Bidder unless specifically exempted in the Bidding Documents.

Bidder's shall comply with the President's Executive Order 11246 as amended and as supplemented by regulations at 41 CFR part 60, which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin.

Bidder's shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Anti-Kickback Act, and the Contract Work Hours Act.
