

OLDHAM COUNTY RECYCLING GUIDE

The Oldham County Recycling Center is located at 3943 Jones Drive across from Oldham County High School. The Center is a free drop-off facility. Staff is on site Monday through Friday. Video-monitoring is used and enforced. Please help keep our facility clean! If in doubt about any item, please call! Accepted items are:

PAPER - Office paper, file folders, envelopes, mail items, magazines/catalogs, newspapers with advertising inserts.

CARDBOARD - All corrugated cardboard containers without packing material, food-free pizza boxes, cereal, dry food and gift boxes. **FLATTEN BOXES TO SAVE SPACE.**

METAL & ALUMINUM - Steel "tin" cans such as soup, vegetable or pet food, clean used aluminum foil, disposable baking pans, beverage cans and clean aluminum food containers.

RIGID PLASTICS - Milk jugs, beverage & laundry containers, food tubs, any bottles and jars marked #1 thru #7 with the recycling symbol.

BATTERIES - Auto, Motorcycle, Boat and Household, such as AAA, AA, C & D and watch and hearing aids.

ELECTRONICS - Televisions, computers, monitors, laptops, tablets, phones, game systems, printers and fax machines without ink cartridges, audio and video players, digital radios and cameras, cords and chargers.

Items Too Big For Your Trash Bin

Oldham County franchise customers are allowed to set out one large item per week on their collection day. LaGrange franchise customers are allowed to set out up to 4 items on the last pickup of each month. All customers **must call** Republic Services to schedule a business day in advance.

Republic allows household residential customers under the Oldham County franchise agreement to take bulky items or extra garbage and yard waste not taken at the curb at any time during normal operating hours to Valley View Landfill. Bring a current service bill and call in advance. See below.

Hours: M-F - 7:00 am-4:00 pm and 2nd & 4th Sat. of each month - 8:00 am noon

Fees: no fees for standard household bulky items and/or yard waste for Oldham County franchise Republic customers only. Bring a current Republic Trash Service Bill and proof of identity. Residents must be capable of unloading their own bulky items.

Accepts everything except hazardous waste: pesticides, oils, antifreeze, fertilizers. Fees may apply for certain items, such as building materials.
